**LESSEE** must notify Force Support Vehicle Operations staff at the office within the first operating hour following vehicle accident. In case of medical emergency, report within the first hour following the accident or release from medical attention, whichever is earliest. **LESSEE** must complete an accident report (Standard Form 91) at Force Support Vehicle Operations building 1290.

**USFJ I 31-205.** The operator of any vehicle involved in an accident on Yokota AB will immediately notify Security Forces and stand by until their arrival. If the operator leaves the scene except to receive medical attention, a report will be generated for Fleeing the Scene of an Accident. In the event of a traffic accident, the POV and GOV vehicle operators will stop, identify themselves, and exchange personal data with those involved in the accident. In traffic accidents involving deaths, bodily injury, immobilization of a vehicle or property damage, the vehicle operator and adult passengers (unless injured and requiring immediate attention) will attend to the injured and not leave the scene of the accident until US forces or GOJ law enforcement authorities have arrived and authorized them to do so. US forces authorities at the scene of the accident will make required reports on behalf of US forces personnel in the event the latter is incapacitated.

Any accident not reported during the contracted date may result in denial of any rental vehicles at Force Support Vehicle Operations.
