YOKOTA ITT TOUR POLICY

Yokota ITT tours are open to all SOFA status members/DoD Card Holders, including active duty military, U.S. DoD civilians, retired military and their dependents. Sponsored guests of eligible customers may participate on ITT tours. Customers must be 18 or older to sign up for ITT tours. Participants 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Local National Employees and JASDF members may sign up for tours starting 7 days prior to the tour date on non-SOFA eligible tours.

Eligible customers are permitted to purchase up to ten tickets. For special tours, customers are permitted to purchase up to five tickets.

Please sign up for tours in person at the ITT office. Reservations over the phone or on Yokota FSS Travel Facebook Page are not accepted.

Please notify ITT staff of any special needs you or your family may have (e.g., wheelchair accessibility, physical or health disabilities, etc.)

Payment for the cost of the tour is due at the time of reservation. The ITT office accepts U.S. dollars, VISA, MasterCard, American Express and U.S. checks. Japanese yen is not accepted. Certain trips offer payment plans and will be indicated on the tour description.

Yokota ITT is not responsible for any accidents due to personal negligence or misconduct on tours. Yokota ITT is not responsible for the loss or damage of personal belongings during tours.

Tour itineraries may change due to traffic and/or other uncontrollable circumstances. The itinerary may also change prior to departure. In the case of itinerary changes, the ITT office will notify passengers registered for the trip as soon as possible.

Trips may be canceled due to unforeseen circumstances. If canceled, the ITT office will notify passengers registered for the trip as soon as possible.






The Tokyo German Village Winter Illumination is one of the biggest winter illumination displays in the Kanto area. Its signature rainbow-colored light tunnel is fun for both kids and adults to walk through. The theme changes each year, and with more than 3 million LED lights, there are various animal and character displays to enjoy. If you get cold, you can warm up with food and drinks from the many vendors. The selection includes German food and beer, as well as Western dishes.

Built on a 650-meter artificial island surrounded by 360° of water, the "Umihotaru Parking Area" is located about midway along the Tokyo Bay Aqua-Line Expressway. This bridge/tunnel combination spans 14 km in total, including a 4.4 km bridge and a 9.6 km tunnel, making it the fourth longest underwater tunnel in the world. The parking area stands five levels tall, with parking on levels 1 through 3 and commercial facilities on levels 4 and 5. It is the only shopping mall on the sea, where you can enjoy panoramic 360° views of Tokyo Bay, as well as a variety of shops, restaurants, and services.















