FIRE WALKING CEREMONY AT MT. TAKAO

SUN • 8 MAR

Hiwatari Matsuri, also known as the Fire-Walking Festival, is a dramatic purification ritual in which participants walk barefoot over a path of smoldering coals. The practice symbolizes the cleansing of one's body, mind, and spirit, as well as the burning away of misfortune and evil influences.

At Mt. Takao's Yakuoin Temple—an ancient Shugendō Buddhist center located near the summit—monks perform powerful ascetic rituals before preparing the fire bed. After chanting and prayers, the priests, followed by lay believers, stride quickly and steadily across the glowing embers. Tradition holds that those who walk with unwavering faith and a calm heart will not be harmed by the heat, while those who hesitate may feel its intensity.









Mt. Takao itself is one of the most beloved natural destinations in the Kanto region. The mountain is known for its rich forests, seasonal foliage, serene hiking trails, and spiritual heritage. From the summit, visitors are rewarded with sweeping views of verdant valleys and distant mountain ranges—on clear days, even Mt. Fuji can be seen. The combination of natural beauty and deep-rooted cultural tradition makes the Hiwatari Matsuri an especially memorable experience for visitors.

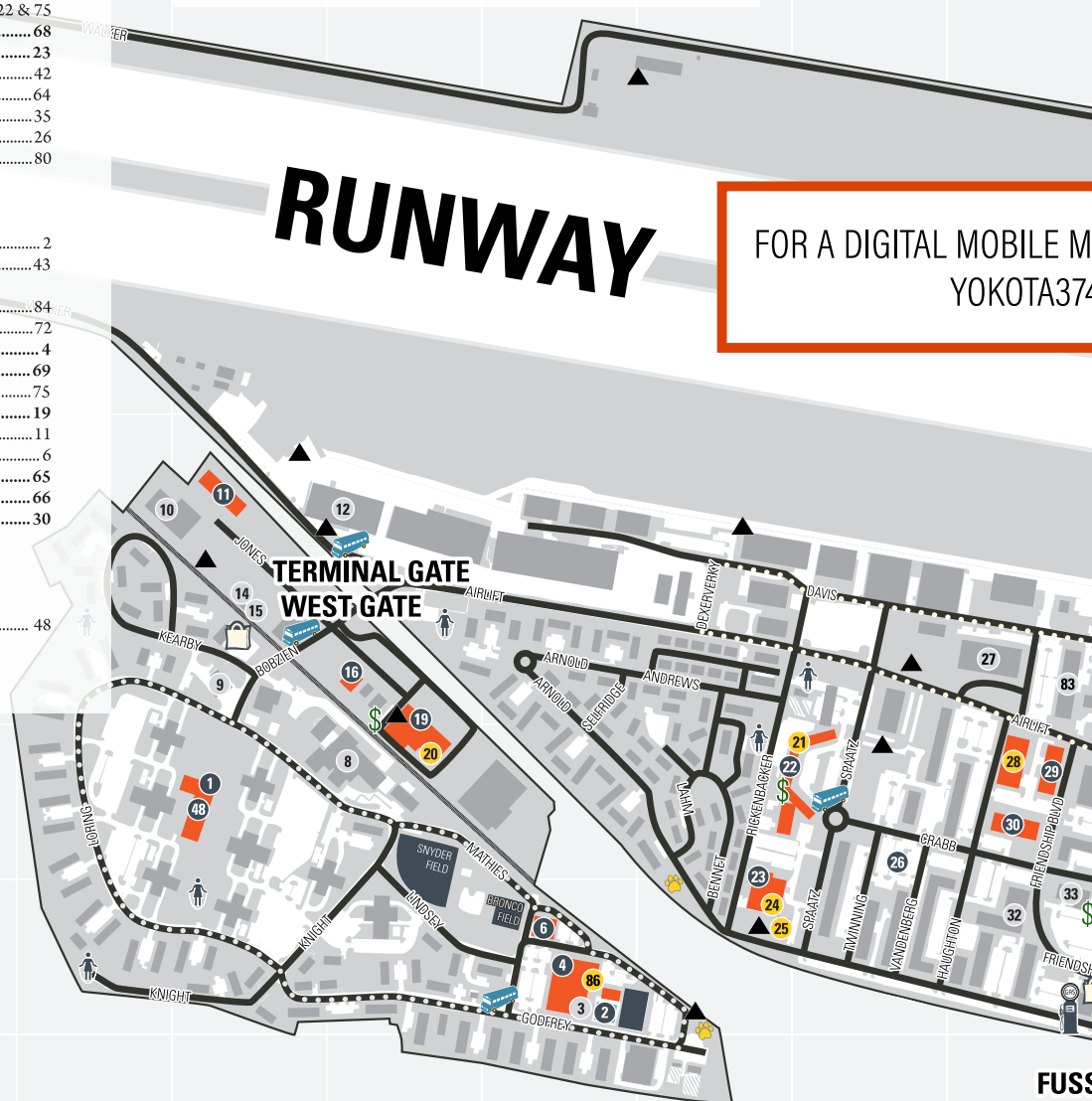

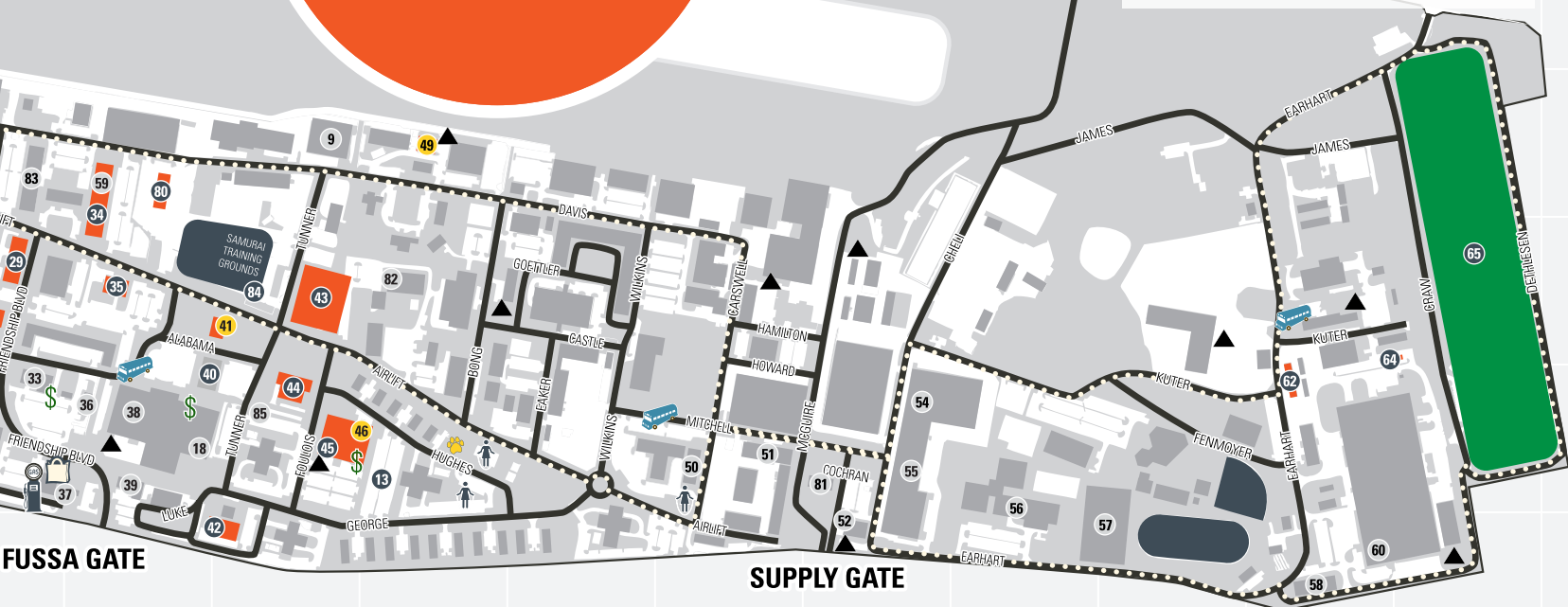
