# Sakura

BEAUTY & BLOOMS

• SEASON IN JAPAN •

**Late March–Early April**

It's spring time! The days are getting warmer, the sun is brighter, lush green grass is growing back, and the cherry blossoms are starting to blanket Japan in pink and white petals that come and go with little time to truly cherish them. Rivers, streets and shrines are lined with people from around the world trying to get a glimpse at the fleeting beauty of the famed sakura trees of Japan. If you are looking for your next adventure, and want to see them in their peak season, check out some of the best locations to see the cherry blossoms before they fall.



## DID YOU KNOW?

McGuire Avenue, located on the east side, is lined with cherry blossoms! Drive down this road in late March as if you're leaving through the Yokota East Gate and enjoy the beautiful blossoms from both sides of the street.





## 1. UENO PARK

---

The paths of Ueno Park are lined with over 1,000 cherry trees, the first of which were planted by Tokugawa Iemitsu, the third shogun of the Tokugawa Shogunate (1603–1868). Located only four stops from Tokyo station, Ueno Park is conveniently placed and a wonderful way for the whole family to see the blossoms. After the festival, the family can stop at the Ueno Zoo or one of the many museums surrounding the area to round out a day of fun.



## 2. SHOWA MEMORIAL PARK

---

*\*BLOOMS A BIT LATER THAN CENTRAL TOKYO.*

Located close to home, in Tachikawa, this is one of my favorite and most frequented parks! Set against wide open lawns and seasonal flower fields, Showa offers a more relaxed and spacious way to enjoy the sakura season nearby. Hundreds of sakura trees line the park's walking paths and open areas, creating a peaceful, less-crowded, atmosphere that's perfect for picnics, with your loved ones or by yourself.



## 3. SHINJUKU GYOEN

---

Featuring more than 1,000 cherry trees of different varieties, blooming at slightly different times, you are likely to find a less crowded spot. Spacious lawn areas covered in abundant green grass, the atmosphere is calm, peaceful, and tranquil. Due to the earlier and later blooming trees, this is the perfect outing for those of you who may miss the main season by a week or two.



## 4. TAMA RIVER (FUSSA)

---

*\*BLOOMS A BIT LATER THAN CENTRAL TOKYO.*

Just a few minutes away, flowing through the heart of Fussa, the Tama River is lined with rows of cherry trees that form a beautiful canopy of soft pink blossoms each spring. The riverside path stretches for several kilometers, making it a great place for scenic walks, runs, bike rides, or a quiet moment to take in the seasonal views. With the gentle flow of the river and blossoms reflecting on the water, this spot offers a serene, picturesque setting that feels like a peaceful escape from the city.
