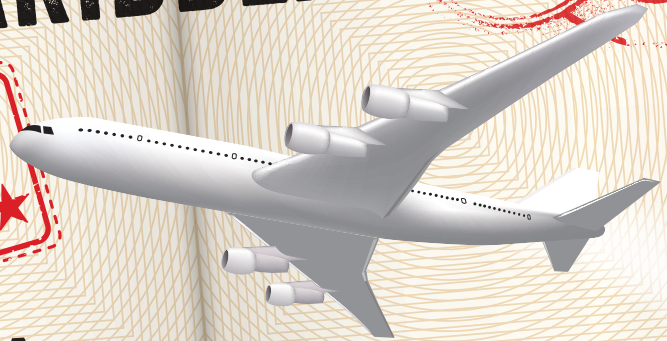

Fuji Shibazakura Flower Park, located near Lake Motosu at the base of Mt. Fuji, is one of the most popular and scenic spots to view Shibazakura—known in English as pink moss or phlox moss. Situated just south of Lake Motosuko in the Fuji Five Lakes area, the festival grounds offer breathtaking views of Mt. Fuji rising behind vast fields of vibrant flowers. Approximately 800,000 Shibazakura plants across five varieties create a stunning carpet of pink, white, and purple hues. Festival stalls add to the experience, offering Shibazakura-themed souvenirs, potted flowers, local produce, and food.

The Fuji Five Lakes region is also famous for its volcanic landscapes, including lava caves, and our visit includes the Wind Cave. We will also stop at the Fuji Subaru Line 5th Station, located about halfway up Mt. Fuji along the Yoshida Trail. As the most accessible and well-developed of the mountain's four 5th stations, it sits at approximately 7,500 feet above sea level and offers spectacular panoramic views of the Fuji Five Lakes below—making it a favorite destination even for visitors not planning to climb the mountain.
