

**YOKOTA ITT TOUR POLICY**

Yokota ITT tours are open to all SOFA status members/DoD Card Holders, including active duty military, U.S. DoD civilians, retired military and their dependents. Sponsored guests of eligible customers may participate on ITT tours. Customers must be 18 or older to sign up for ITT tours. Participants 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Local National Employees and JASDF members may sign up for tours starting 7 days prior to the tour date on non-SOFA eligible tours.

Eligible customers are permitted to purchase up to ten tickets. For special tours, customers are permitted to purchase up to five tickets.

Please sign up for tours in person at the ITT office. Reservations over the phone or on Yokota FSS Travel Facebook Page are not accepted.

Please notify ITT staff of any special needs you or your family may have (e.g., wheelchair accessibility, physical or health disabilities, etc.)

Payment for the cost of the tour is due at the time of reservation. The ITT office accepts U.S. dollars, VISA, MasterCard, American Express and U.S. checks. Japanese yen is not accepted. Certain trips offer payment plans and will be indicated on the tour description.

Yokota ITT is not responsible for any accidents due to personal negligence or misconduct on tours. Yokota ITT is not responsible for the loss or damage of personal belongings during tours.

Tour itineraries may change due to traffic and/or other uncontrollable circumstances. The itinerary may also change prior to departure. In the case of itinerary changes, the ITT office will notify passengers registered for the trip as soon as possible.

Trips may be canceled due to unforeseen circumstances. If canceled, the ITT office will notify passengers registered for the trip as soon as possible.

Please read the brochure's tour descriptions thoroughly. There will be rest stops on all tours lasting over two hours. It is recommended that you bring enough yen to cover the cost of snacks and meals. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to departure time to allow yourself enough time to check in and find a seat. The bus will depart promptly on schedule.

Buses for all ITT tours depart from the parking lot between the Enlisted Club and building 2000. We ask that all passengers return to the same seat taken at the beginning of the tour and return to the bus on time as directed by the tour guide.

Parents must ensure their children are well behaved and do not disturb other passengers. Listening and/or watching videos, music, etc. is permitted with the use of headphones. Please refrain from talking on the phone while seated on the bus.

Yokota ITT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate group seating when requested. However, due to seating and ticket availability, this may not always be possible.

**YOKOTA TOUR WAIT-LIST POLICY**

A waiting list is available for tours that have reached maximum capacity. If there are any cancellations, ITT staff will contact those on the waiting list at most three times via phone. If there is no answer, ITT will move on to the next person on the list. Customers are responsible for making sure that the contact information provided is correct.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER**

All tour cancellations due to inclement weather will be determined by 4 p.m. the day before the scheduled tour.

Customers will be notified by 6 p.m. the day before.

For multi-day trips where inclement weather causes an overnight delay, customers will be responsible to pay the associated additional cost.

Refunds are provided for cancellations made four or more business days prior to the tour date. Cancellations made after four business days will not be refunded.

The city of Kofu travels back in time at the Shingen-ko Festival honoring Takeda Shingen, the famous warlord of the Sengoku Era. Replicas of Furinkazan, the representative flag of Lord Shingen, are seen all over the city. The highlight of the festival is battling march of the Takeda Army, comprised of local citizens dressed in authentic costumes of Shingen's famous twenty-four generals and more than 1,500 warriors marching along with torches. The deployment reenactment will be led by an actor playing Takeda Shingen. After the deployment ceremony at the main stage with a sake ritual and toast, Takeda Shingen, bathed in torchlight and surrounded by his twenty-four generals, leads his army along the streets of Kofu City. The Fu-Rin-Ka-Zan banner, representing a philosophy Shingen adopted from Sun Tzu's "Art of War", is displayed by his marching army.

Everyone will find something of interest here. Tourists come to this Enoshima Island to walk the pathways that lead to several ancient temples, botanical gardens, museums, parks, scenic overlooks, and a modern lighthouse at the top of the island. If you are not in great shape for the stairs and hills, escalator for 360 yen. A one-day pass is also available which includes escalator, Samuel Cocking Garden, Sea Candle and the Iwaya Caves. The classic view of Mt. Fuji as depicted on Japanese art can be seen from Enoshima on clear days.

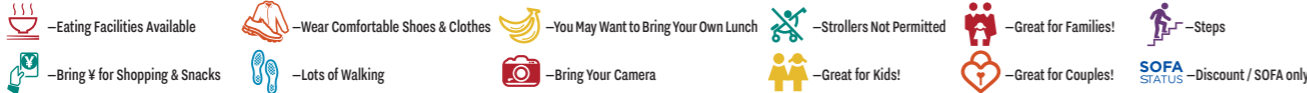

Arakurayama Fuji Sengen Shrine and its iconic five-story pagoda sit within scenic Arakurayama Sengen Park, one of the most picturesque spots for viewing Mount Fuji. One of the most breathtaking perspectives of this spectacular mountain can be enjoyed from Chureito Pagoda. Reaching it requires climbing nearly 400 steps or walking the uphill path, but every step is rewarded with unforgettable views.

Visit the delightful Fujisan Herb Garden, where seasonal herbs, flowers, and panoramic views of Mt. Fuji create a relaxing and fragrant stop to enjoy nature and local products. Oshino Village is a charming traditional village in the Fuji Five Lakes area, located between Lake Kawaguchi and Lake Yamanaka on the site of a former sixth lake that dried up several hundred years ago. The village is known for its eight crystal-clear ponds, fed by snowmelt from Mt. Fuji that filters through porous lava layers for over 80 years.

Hakone National Park is part of the Fuji-Hakone-Izu National Park, less than 100 kilometers from Tokyo. Famous for its volcanic landscapes and hot springs, Hakone National Park is one of the most popular destinations among Japanese and international

tourists. See a sweeping view of the National Park from the aerial cable car and at the valley "Owakudani" (Hell Valley), where you will see smoking volcanic activity and be able to sample the volcanic cooked black eggs. Enjoy the natural scenery and a delightful boat ride across Lake Ashi. Hakone Checkpoint used to be an important checkpoint to control traffic along the Tokaido highway which linked Tokyo with Kyoto during the feudal Edo Period. This checkpoint-controlled weapons from being brought into Edo and also kept women and children from fleeing Edo. It was in operation for more than 260 yrs, until 1868, when the Edo period changed to the Meiji period. Hakone Shrine stands at the foot of Mt. Hakone along the shores of Lake Ashi. Founded in 757, this shrine is known for its large red torii gate that stands in the lake.

Yokohama is Japan's second most populated city with 3.6 million residents and located approximately 18 miles south of Tokyo. As the nation's foremost seaport, Yokohama has long been noted for its sophisticated international atmosphere. Your first stop will be a visit and lunch at Chinatown, followed by a stop at the historic Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse, a charming waterfront complex of restored brick buildings now home to unique boutiques, cafés, and local specialty shops. You'll also have time to stroll around the scenic waterfront promenade, take in views of the harbor, and enjoy the relaxing seaside atmosphere.

Its name, meaning "white threads," perfectly captures the delicate streams cascading down the rock face, and it is recognized as one of Japan's 100 greatest waterfalls. You'll also enjoy a buffet-style lunch at the Fuji Highland Resort Hotel, featuring a delicious selection of Western, Italian, and Japanese dishes. The tour also includes a relaxing visit to the Fujisan Herb Garden, where you can stroll among fragrant seasonal herbs and flowers, browse charming local products, and soak in peaceful countryside scenery. The journey continues up the Subaru Line to the 5th Station of Mt. Fuji, where spectacular views of this iconic and majestic volcano await—so be sure to bring your camera to capture the scenery.

This historical tour takes you to the burial site of Takeda Shingen, a legendary samurai warlord of Japan's Warring States period, who died in 1572 while journeying to Kyoto in pursuit of the title of shogun, the nation's supreme military commander. The temple is also renowned for its exquisite garden, designed by Musō Kokushi, a revered high priest of the samurai era. Continuing into Chichibu National Park, you'll take a cable car up Mt. Kimpū—the park's highest peak—to the breathtaking Shosenkyo Gorge, carved by the Arakawa River. Don't forget your camera to capture the dramatic cliffs and fantastically shaped rock formations.

The scenic island of Miyajima is renowned for Itsukushima Shrine, famous for its iconic vermilion torii gate that appears to float on the sea at high tide, creating one of Japan's most breathtaking views. In Hiroshima, take a reflective walk through Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park, a moving site dedicated to remembrance and the global pursuit of peace, featuring monuments and memorials that share the city's story and hopeful message for the future. In Kure, discover the area's rich maritime heritage through engaging museums, waterfront sights, and fascinating exhibits.

Visitors can stroll beneath cascading trellises and tunnel-like canopies of blossoms, often considered among the most beautiful wisteria displays in Japan, all accompanied by the sweet fragrance of the flowers and beautifully landscaped gardens.

Sano Premium Outlet is a large shopping complex with more than 180 shops and restaurants, offering a wide selection of well-known domestic and international brands.
